## 'TRAC FACTS

- Headquartered in Atlanta, Georgia, family-owned RaceTrac has been **serving guests since 1934**.
- RaceTrac is the **second largest** privately held company in Georgia and the **22nd largest** private company in the United States.
- In total, RaceTrac **employs more than 10,200 team members** across our two divisions (RaceTrac and RaceWay) and affiliated companies (Metroplex Energy and Energy Dispatch).
- **Total RaceTrac Stores: 567** (Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, Tennessee, Texas)
- **Total RaceWay Stores: 217** (Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, Virginia)
- To date, we have **invested approximately \$81M** to support alternative fuels infrastructure at our stores, so that we can offer a variety of renewable fuel blends (e.g., E85, E15, E0, etc.) to our guests.
- On average, RaceTrac handles **over 260M transactions per year**—nearly 12 times the entire population of Florida (22M). In 2022, RaceTrac paid **approximately \$130M in swipe fees**.
- In 2023, RaceTrac is planning on investing **approximately \$455M** across our operating states.
- Metroplex Energy sells approximately **5B gallons of fuel annually**.
- Energy Dispatch **employs more than 250 drivers and operates 98 tractor-trailers out of 6 states**. Energy Dispatch also **delivers over 1.2B gallons of fuel** each year.

## 2022 IN NUMBERS

All of our RaceTrac locations offer guests an affordable one-stop shop featuring a wide selection of food, beverage, and competitively priced fuel. In 2022, we sold:



- **28.2M** roller grill items (lined up, these egg rolls, hot dogs, and taquitos would be over 2.5K miles long – nearly the distance between Miami, FL and San Francisco, CA)



- **27.2M** cups of Crazy Good Coffee (approximately enough coffee to give one cup to each resident of Florida and South Carolina)



- **18.9M** slices of pizza sold (enough pizza to cover nearly 57 football fields)



- **13.9M** fresh food items (approximately enough sandwiches, salads, and parfaits to share with each resident of Alabama, Kentucky, and Louisiana)



- **2.4M** whole fruit items sold (i.e., we sell over 46K pieces of fresh fruits a week)



- **1.1M** gallons of milk (enough milk to fill over 26K average-sized bathtubs)

## EFFICIENCY & SUSTAINABILITY

In 2012, RaceTrac created a special team to further efficiency consciousness and sustainability. Since then, we've saved a lot of energy and water:



**LED Lighting** – 201M kWh **saved** across our footprint (enough to power the White House for 236 years)



**Energy Management Systems** – 3.6B kWh **saved** (enough to power 338 single-family homes for a year)



**Smart Irrigation** – \$2.4M and 474M gallons of water **saved** (enough water to fill 718 Olympic-sized swimming pools)



**Water Usage & Leak Detection** – \$1.5M and 235M gallons of water **saved** (enough water to fill 37 Ocean Voyager tanks at the Georgia Aquarium)

**RaceWay** is RaceTrac's solely franchised brand.



**Metroplex Energy, Inc.** is a wholly owned subsidiary of RaceTrac, which purchases and secures its own supply of bulk fuel to supply RaceTrac and RaceWay stores. Metroplex transports all of its fuel products by rail, pipeline, truck, and barge across 15 states (Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Indiana, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maryland, Mississippi, North Carolina, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, Virginia).



**Energy Dispatch** is a RaceTrac-affiliated fuel transportation company that provides fuel transportation services for RaceTrac and RaceWay stores across 6 states in the southern U.S. (Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Louisiana, Tennessee, Texas).
